AS A RESULT OF A SUGGESTION BY DON PIRIE, A STRIDER CHARTER MEMBER, AND DISCUSSION DURING AN INFORMAL MEETING AT CLUB TREASURER JOHN MARTINS' HOME IN AUGUST, A SERIES OF CLUB RUNS HAS BEEN ORGANIZED. FIRST OF THESE RUNS WILL TAKE PLACE ON SUNDAY, 22 OCT 72 AT FORT SHANTOK STATE PARK AT 10:30 A.M. (TAKE RT. 32 SOUTH FROM NORWICH TURN OFF IS ON LEFT IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE MONEGAN PEQUOT UNDERPASS). WE'RE HOPING FOR A GOOD TURNOUT AS THIS RUN WILL TESTIFY TO THE INTEREST FOR THE PROPAGATION OF FUTURE CLUB RUNS. THE COURSE CONSISTS OF A TWO MILE LOOP AROUND THE STATE PARK AND IS ALMOST ENTIRELY ON THE GRASS AND THROUGH WE INTEND TWO SEPARATE RUNS, ONE OF A SINGLE LOOP (TWO MILES) AND THE SECOND OF TWO OR POSSIBLY THREE LOOPS (4-6 MILES). WITH INTERESTED MEMBERS MAKING THEIR OWN CHOICE. HOPE TO SEE ALL OF YOU THERE.

THE STRIDERS PROVED THAT THEY ARE READY TO MEET THE BEST AS THEY BUNCHED THEIR FIVE SCORERS IN THE TOP TEN AT THIS YEARS LEDYARD FAIR RACE. ON THE 9TH OF SEPTEMBER THIS YEAR, TIM SMITH (3RD), HENRY DARICEK (5TH), GENE MCMERRIMAN (6TH), MIKE MYSHKA (8TH), AND ED REYNOLDS (10TH) COMBINED FOR THE LOW SCORE OF 32 POINTS - A TREMENDOUS POINT TOTAL IN ANY MEET = TO COP A VERY NICE TEAM TROPHY, THE TROPHY IS ON DISPLAY AT CLUB SECRATARY BOB CARBRAYS HOME IN LEDYARD, CT. THIS WAS THE FIRST LOCAL RACE TO DISPLAY OUR SHIRTS AND THE SIGHT WAS QUITE IMPRESSIVE AND STIMULATED A TRUE AIR OF TOGETHERNESS. REMEMBER THE SHIRTS ARE A SIGN OF YOUR FELLOW CLUB MEMBERS - SAY HELLO; INTRODUCE YOURSELVES; GET TO

AL WILLIAMS (A CLUB MEMBER) DID A TREMENDOUS JOB IN COMBINING HIS INITIATIVE, ORGANIZATIONAL ABILITY, AND ROADRUNNING KNOWLEDGE TO AGAIN EXECUTE A FLAWLESS RACE. FROM THE CLUB AL. THANKS AGAIN!!!!!!

ON OCTOBER 1ST NEARLY TWENTY CLUB MEMBERS PARTICIPATED IN THE ANNUAL SOME BRISTOL MUM-A-THON 8 MILE RACE. FINE PERFORMANCES WERE ROAD ALL STRIDERS RECORDED; THE MOST GRATIFING BEING THAT WERE ABLE FINNISH THE JAUNT, FORMER UCONN STANDOUT STEVE FLANAGAN, MADE THE MOST OF HIS FIRST OFFICIAL "LONG" RACE IN SOME TIME IN GRABBING A THIRD TOUGH FIELD PACED BY JOHN VITALE (1ST WHAT ELSE?), AND BOB LEES (2ND). OUR OWN GENE MCMERRIMAN COPPED 1ST PLACE IN THE SUB-MASTERS DIVISION AND WAS JOINED IN THAT HIGHLY TOUTED TOP TEN CIRCLE BY (34 - 40)ANOTHER OF OUR NUMBER, AL WILLIAMS. HENRY DARICEK WAS OUR SECOND MAN PLACING 15TH IN THE RACE, JUST TWO SPOTS AHEAD OF GENE. JIM VITAGLIAND. A VERITABLE TOWER OF STRENGTH COMING TO US FROM THAT SHADY ITALIAN UNDERGROUND, FINISHED A VERY RESPECTABLE 36TH, 30 PLACES AND SOME 3.5 MINUTES BETTER THAN THE PREVIOUS YEAR, THE RACE PROVED ENJOYABLE DAY FOR ALL, MAYBE WE'LL SEE MORE OF YOU THERE NEXT YEAR.

THE 23RD OF NOVEMBER MARKS THE DATE OF THIS YEARS ANNUAL "TURKEY DAY RUN IN MANCHESTER , CT. IT IS A VERY FAST FIVE MILE ROAD RACE AND THERE IS ALWAYS A LARGE FIELD OF RUNNERS PRESENT, LAST YEAR THE FIELD HELD TO ONLY 250 RUNNERS AS A BLIZZARD THE PREVIOUS NIGHT LEFT APPROX. ONE FOOT OF SNOW AND VERY ICY FOOTING OVER THE ENTIRE COURSE. AS A TUNE THE FAST PACE OF THE MANCHESTER FIVE, THE J. FRED MARTIN 4.25 FOR MILE ROAD RACE IN MIDDLETOWN, CONN, (WESLYAN UNIVERSITY) ON THE-19TH OF YEAR, IS ALWAYS A GOOD ONE. THE BERNIE O'ROURKE DIRECTED, NOV THIS MIDDLETOWN ROAD RACES (OF WHICH THERE ARE NO LESS THAN 12 PER YEAR) ARE EFFICIENTLY RUN. WELL SPOKEN OF AND ATTENDED BY ROAD RUNNERS IN THE NEW ENGLAND AREA. I EXPECT THAT THE STRIDERS BE WELL WILL REPRESENTED IN BOTH OF THESE UNCOMING RACES AND IT WOULDN'T BE AT ALL SURPRISING TO SEE A COUPLE OF OUTSTANDING RACES FOR THE TEAM TROPHY'S AGAINST SOME VERY STIFF COMPETITION NOT THE LEAST OF WHICH ARE -C,C,A,A, HARTFORD TRACK CLUB, AND THE STRATFORD SPARTANS. HOPE TO SEE SOME OF YOU ON THE 19TH AND 22ND THIS YEAR.

AS MOST OF YOU PROBABLY KNOW, FRANK SHORTER, OF THE FLORDIA TRACK CLUB AND MEMBER OF THIS YEARS UNITED STATES OLYMPIC TEAM, WON THE OLYMPIC MARATHON IN MUNICH IN THE NEAR RECORD TIME OF 2 HOURS, 12 MINUTES 19.7 SECONDS. CLOSER TO HOME, THIS IMPRESSIVE FEAT BRINGS TO MIND A COUPLE OF NAMES ON THE CONNECTICUT RUNNING SCENE, THESE BEING JOHN VITALE AND NORM HIGGINS. JOHN AND NORM BOTH QUALIFIED FOR AND RAN IN THE OLYMPIC TRIALS MARATHON HELD IN EUGENE, OREGON IN AUGUST OF THIS YEAR, THE OLYMPIC TRIALS MARATHON IS JUST THAT, A TRIAL, ONLY THE FIRST THREE PLACES COUNT SO THAT A 4TH PLACE FINISH IS JUST THE SAME AS 54TH PLACE,

BUT THE POINT HERE IS THAT THOSE INDIVIDUALS WHO DID PARTICIPATE IN THE TRIAL NEED HAVE NOTHING TO BE ASHAMED OF, THESE MEN WERE NOT JUST BEATEN IN A RACE BY A VERY GOOD RUNNER THESE MEN WERE BEATEN BY THE BEST MARATHONER IN THE WORLD TODAY, A WORLD CLASS MARATHONER, FRANK SHORTER. THIS IS A POINT INDICATIVE OF THE TYPE OF DISTANCE RUNNER AMERICA CAN AND IS PRODUCING TODAY AND IF CLUBS SUCH AS OURS CAN CONTINUE TO PROMOTE RUNNING AND PHYSICAL FITNESS THEN THE WORLD CAN LOOK FORWARD TO A GREAT DEAL MORE WORLD CLASS AMERICAN RUNNERS. —HEIDTMAN—
