Tribune Reported Rumors Confirmed!

Special by Benjamin Colder, RON. As reported in the **Tribune**, there was, in fact, a meeting at the home of John Martin on March 30, 1972. Reliable sources confirmed the purpose of the meeting was to discuss forming a running club. The meeting, reportedly held on April 9, 1972 apparently resulted in the formation of the Mohegan Striders running club. Beside promoting running for sport and fitness, the nascent Club applied for sanction by the AAU (Big Mean Governing Body for Running). Such sanction will resolve the unattached runner issue reported earlier in the **Tribune**. Both the New London Day and Norwich Bulletin reported on May 16 that the Mohegan Striders have received AAU Sanction. Following AAU Sanction approval, there is a 30-day waiting period, presumably to allow Club members to reattach. By June 16, Mohegan Strider runners need not run unattached going forward.
